ELIGIBILITY

You are eligible to enter if you meet the following requirements at time of entry:

- **You are** at least 13-17 years old as of 1 Jan 2019 and are actively enrolled as a student at an accredited educational institution that grants high-school at any time between 1 January 2015 and 31 December 2019
- Team members must be from the same school

TEAMS AND SUPERVISORS

Up to two (2) eligible students may submit a single entry as a team. It is recommended that each team (or individual if competing alone) enlist the services of a supervisor. Supervisors may be from your academic institutions.

You may have assistance with your project from additional students beyond the two who are your official team. Such assistance is typically in the area of specific disciplines such as graphic design or business plan development. Any such additional students are not considered members of your team for purposes of these rules and they will not be eligible for any prizes, they will not be included in the award ceremony, nor will they be recognized in official communications such as press releases. Only the two team members you officially register with us are eligible for prizes, award ceremony inclusion, and official communications.

- Each team is allowed only one supervisor.
 - Each competitor may belong to only one team within the competition
 - To compete, each team should go to <https://goo.gl/forms/I7FMRhnUQJzySRhI2> and register for the competition.
 - Each Team is solely responsible for its own cooperation and teamwork. In no event will Sponsor officiate in any dispute regarding the conduct or cooperation of any Team or its members.
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- The intent and spirit of the Competition is to test the skills and creativity of the student entrants. Anyone acting as a team Supervisor, or in any supervisorship role, where allowed (, must limit the level of support provided to student entrants to general guidance and must not contribute in any way that may be considered original authorship, or in a way that may enable claims of rights or ownership to the submitted entries. In no event will work-on-behalf of teams or individuals be allowed.

COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1) The competition is open to students from secondary schools.
- 2) Each team must elect a team captain/team representative who will act as a contact point with organizers.
- 3) Team names that contain vulgar, explicit, offensive or inappropriate content will lead to the immediate dismissal of the entire team from the UGME event.
- 4) If a team is dismissed from the event, the members of the team will not be admitted to re-enter the competition on different teams. The decisions made by the organizers will be final.
- 5) Scores rendered by the judges will not be disclosed to the competition organizers.
- 6) Contest Rules and Conduct may change at any time from time to time at the sole discretion of the competition's organizers. The participants must agree that the organizers, with their sole discretion, will determine a change of rule if it's appropriate and will not incur any liability for said determination.
- 7) Limitation of participants – the following people may not enter the competition: - (a) organizers of the competition (b) with respect of a given competition technology, any inventors of that specific technology.
- 8) Judges' decisions are final and are not subject to review

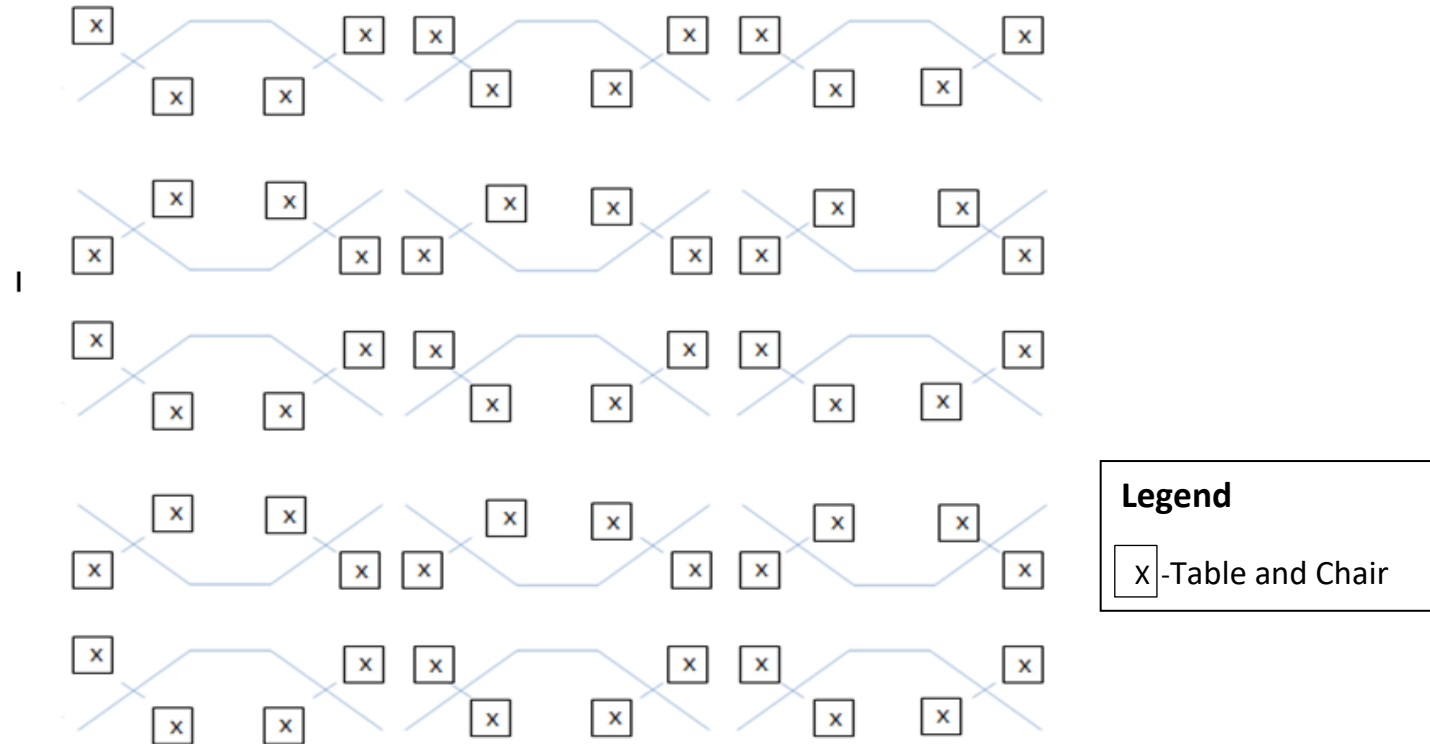
WHAT DO PARTICIPANTS NEED TO BRING?

- Each team will be provided with two panels with the dimensions of each panel is 70cm x 180cm and the two panels are connected to each other

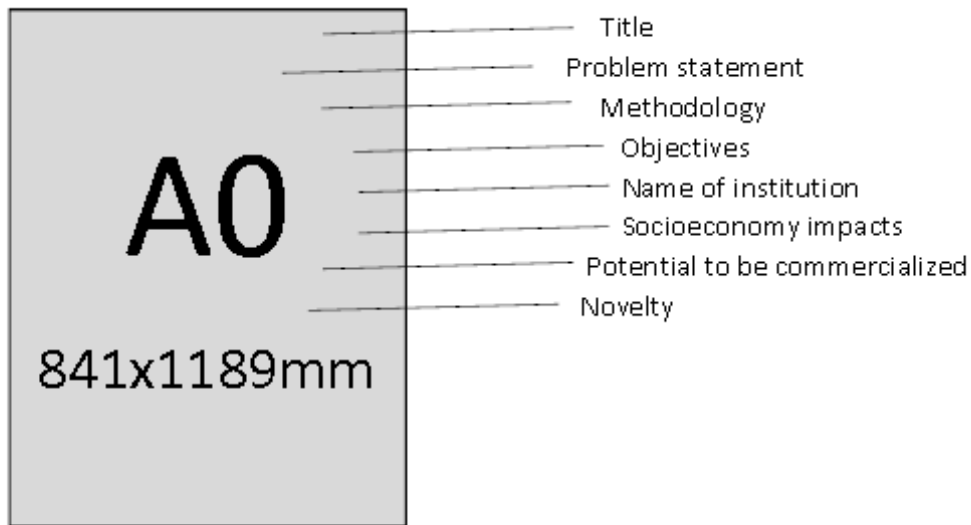
FLOOR PLAN
